Cleaning a Gaming Console

Gaming consoles, including Xboxes and PlayStations, can be wiped down with a cleaning wipe such as Oxivir, Cavicide, alcohol wipes, or other cleaning products. Be careful not to get the console too wet, since too much moisture can damage the electronics.

Cleaning Video Game Controllers

Gaming controllers, both wired and wireless, can be wiped down with a cleaning wipe such as Oxivir, Cavicide, alcohol wipes, or other cleaning products. Be careful not to get the controllers too wet, since too much moisture can damage the controllers. For tight spaces around toggles or buttons, we recommend a Q-Tip with a small amount of cleaning solution on the tip.

Cleaning Tablets

Tablets, including iPads and Kindles, can be wiped down with a cleaning wipe such as Oxivir, Cavicide, alcohol wipes, or other cleaning products. Be careful not to get the tablet too wet, since too much moisture can damage the tablet.
